4. Review and Publication Policy

All submitted manuscripts are peer-reviewed by subject experts.

- The journal follows a fair, unbiased, and confidential review process.
- Only original and plagiarism-free articles are accepted for publication.
- The journal follows ethical standards in accordance with academic and publication ethics.

5. Editorial Policy

- The journal accepts original and unpublished manuscripts only.
- Submissions must be relevant to the scope of education, humanities, or multidisciplinary research.
- Articles are selected based on academic merit, clarity, originality and relevance.
- The editorial board has the right to accept, revise or reject any manuscript.
- Final publication decisions rest with the Editor-in-Chief and Editorial Board.

6. Peer-Review Policy:

- Each manuscript is reviewed by two subject experts.
- Reviewers evaluate papers on originality, methodology, relevance and presentation.

- All manuscripts must follow the APA referencing style (latest edition) as prescribed by the journal.
- Manuscripts should be original, unpublished and not under consideration elsewhere.
- A Declaration of Originality duly signed by the author(s) must be submitted along with the manuscript.
